David would like to share with his students his passion for making art with this intriguing style of painting that is so different from other mediums.

During this 8-week course, he will show how to compose and plan your paintings to achieve the spontaneity and effects that we all love about watercolour. You will learn the processes of painting 'wet on dry', 'wet on wet' and separating wet and dry areas. You will discover more about the unique qualities of transparent paint and using the white of the paper to effect the light in our painting. Using a variety of set pieces that include landscapes, seascapes and life forms, we will learn techniques that we can develop and build confidence to inevitably produce paintings that reflect our own style.

David will also show how important all the components, paper, paint and brushes are to achieving successful watercolours. Due to the importance of specific materials in achieving consistent outcomes, he has available at cost price, Arches 300gsm paper as an option for students to purchase and use. This, he says "gives us a good starting point so we are all on the same level playing field, achieving consistent effects.

This course is for students who have had little previous experience using Watercolours and have their own materials. A materials list is supplied as a suggestion to useful materials that may be included.
